Apply for the Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in Business and Management.

How are courses delivered?

Kaufmann/-frau International (AHK)

After completing the PDP course you can apply for the Kaufmann/-frau International Certificate (KIC). The KIC is a recognised certificate and “converts” your kaufmännische Ausbildung into an international Kaufmann/-frau.

- Awarded by the German-British Chamber of Industry and Commerce (AHK London), which operates under the umbrella of the German Association of Chambers of Industry and Commerce (Deutscher Industrie- und Handelskammertag, DIHK Berlin).
- Certificate holders prove that they are able to operate in an international business environment.
